Scholarship Requirements:

Eligibility for this college scholarship will be as follows:

1. Scholarship applicants must be a member or dependent of a member who has been in good standing of Laborers' Local #1309 prior to submitting an application.

2. Dependent status of a member will be defined as:

Member's Spouse- Lawful spouse

Member's Children- Any children up to twenty-five (25) years of age if enrolled as a fulltime student. Children include legally adopted children, step-children, or any children for whom by court order you are legally responsible.

3. Applicants must be selected for a scholarship by a subcommittee of the Executive Board of Laborers' Local #1309.

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Administration Policies

1. The number of scholarships awarded each year will be determined by the Executive Board of Laborers Local #1309.

2. The scholarship will be evaluated by a subcommittee of the Executive Board of Laborers' Local #1309. The subcommittee will select the scholarship winners from among the eligible applicants.

3. Scholarships will be awarded up to the amount of three thousand dollars (\$3,000) payable in the amounts of one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500) once per year, provided the recipient remains eligible.

4. Those awarded scholarships begin to receive payment upon presentation of verification of the enrollment as a full-time student, no less than twelve (12) units, to commence at least sixty (60) days from the award of the scholarship. The checks will be deposited in the winning students' names at the college or university they plan to attend.

5. To continue to receive the remainder of the scholarship payments, the recipient must:

A. Maintain a minimum grade point average of 2.7

B. Present proof of enrollment in the next semester and official transcripts from all classes taken while a recipient of this scholarship, and

C. Maintain Local Union membership status (recipient must be a member in continuous good standing of Local #1309 or the dependent of such a member, provided that no scholarship shall continue after a member's child reaches the age of twenty-five (25) years of age.

6. Failure to comply with the above-mentioned criteria may disqualify the recipient for the remainder of the scholarship. Issues of disqualification will be decided by a subcommittee of the Executive Board of Laborers' Local #1309.

7. No officers or employees of the Local Union will be eligible to apply for this scholarship.

8. Any issue arising under the scholarship will be decided by the appointed scholarship administrators with approval of the full Executive Board of Laborers' Local #1309. All such decisions are final.
